I would like to take this time to introduce myself. I am Aisha Weaver. I am the Director of Special Services and Assistant Principal for the North Hampton School. I am very excited to meet and work with each and every student and family in our school community. These last 2 weeks have been a whirlwind and learning experience.

Prior to my arrival here at North Hampton School, I was employed with Easterseals NH for over 12 years. I began my time at ESNH as a Family Support and Stabilization Program Manager. In this role, I worked with families who were identified by the Department of Children and Families of needing supports to stabilize their home before more restrictive measures would be explored. In the Fall of 2009, I transitioned to the position of a Special Education Teacher. I was responsible for the direct instruction of a self-contained classroom. In addition to providing direct instruction, I developed and implemented my students' IEPs. I then transitioned to my position as an Educational Case Manager and I was tasked with the development and implementation of students IEPs; facilitation of student meetings; and collaboration with service providers, both internal and external.

As a Curriculum Coordinator, I was able to take what I learned as a Special Education Teacher and Case Manager and develop a K-12 curriculum that had resources for Special Education Teachers and Paraprofessionals. I continued my collaborative work with service providers, school districts, teachers and administrators. It was a joy to see the students' progress towards mastery of their IEP goals and their academic goals.
