








#### Phonemic Awareness

- Phonemic awareness is about being able to hear and manipulate the smallest unit of sound, a phoneme!
- Examples: rhyming, initial sound, final sound, deletion, substitution, nonsense words






#### **Fundations**

- Helps students develop letter-sound relationships, solidifying the foundation of their reading and writing skills.
- Initially reviewed the 26 letters, their keywords, and their sounds, as well as letter formation.
- Upcoming: blending sounds into words, learning other sounds (like ch, sh, long vowels, etc.), learning \*Trick Words\*










#### Read Alouds


- Create a class bond

  - Information: UofS








### Snack
